PROFILES

DEBÓRAH BOND (singer) was born in New Haven, Connecticut, and is now based in Washington DC. Bond and her production team and band, Third Logic, have successfully mixed elements of jazz, funk, progressive r&b, and British Soul, gaining an international following in the United States, the United Kingdom, and abroad. Their latest CD release, Madam Palindrome, a concept album as shared by Bond, is a collection of songs giving infinite perspectives on life, love, music, and the creative vision through visual art. A compilation of music perfection, Madam Palindrome hit #1 on the UK Soul Charts for three weeks and considered one of the best soul albums by Echoes magazine, with featured videos on VH1 Soul, BET, and MTV UK for the sinale "You Are The One."

KRISTOPHER FUNN (writer, musical director, bass) was born and raised in Baltimore, Maryland. After graduating from Howard University with an honors degree in computer science. Kristopher decided to pursue a career as a professional jazz musician. He has performed and toured internationally to every major jazz festival in the world with artists such as Kenny Garrett, Christian Scott Nicholas Payton, Jeff Majors, and Pharaoh Sanders. Funn has also appeared and written songs on several recordings including Christian Scott's latest album, Christian Atunde Adjuah. BAYE HARRELL (writer, lyricist) has embraced the title of Hip Hop Theater Artist to best encompass his multiple jobs. She completed her Bachelor of Science degree in computer technology with courses in visual communication and digital media arts. DANTE' POPE (percussion and vocalist, Vol. 1 and 3) is a charismatic and exciting musician in Washington. A native of Chicago, Illinois, he blends his gospel roots with a soulful swing that has entertained Washingtonians at venues such as the Howard Theatre, Blues Alley, and Bohemian Caverns. Pope provides personalized private lessons in addition to his work as percussion instructor at the District of Columbia Music Center. He attended the Merit School of Music in Chicago, Illinois, where he had masterclasses with Yo-Yo Ma, Evelyn Glennie, and Robin Eubanks. At Fisk University, he was a member of the worldrenowned Fisk Jubilee Singers. Pope has also played with many other great musicians such as Chicago Youth Symphony Orchestra, Anthony Hamilton, Eric Clapton, and Moses Hogan.

SAM PRATHER (piano) is an exciting and multifaceted musician from Washington DC. Prather has developed a reputation in the local music scene performing and producing with all types of acts. On the funk/soul side Prather has worked on keyboards with YaMama'Nym, 76 Degrees West, and Brandon Combs. On the jazz side he has graced the stage with Heidi Martin, Warren Wolf, Antonio Parker, and Joey Omicil. She also works on stage management and choreography projects, collaborating with the University of Maryland and Catholic University. She currently resides in New York City where she loves being a contemporary cake artist and running her own custom cake company #LisaVivoCustomCakes.
