PROFILES

NIDIA GÓNGORA

The “Maestra Nidia Góngora,” widely known as the most recognized singer from the Colombian Pacific coast, won the 2016 Shock Award for Best Folk Album, and was nominated for a 2019 Latin Grammy for Best Folk Album. She holds a degree in early childhood education and is a singer and researcher of traditional music from the Southern Colombian Pacific.

Throughout her more than 20 years of experience as a composer and performer, Professor Góngora has successfully built bridges between the traditional music of her native Timbiquí (Cauca) and other world music genres. She bears the innate tradition inherited from her elders: her mother, matron Libia Oliva Bonilla; her teacher, Elizabeth Sinisterra; her father, Isaac Góngora; and the leading singers of her community.

Góngora founded, directs, and is lead vocalist of the musical group Canalón de Timbiquí. The ensemble has received many awards at the Pacific Music Festival “Petronio Álvarez,” including Best Vocal Performance, Best Vocal Arrangement, and Best Marimba Ensemble. Her voice is immortalized in Colombian Pacific anthems like “Quítate de mí Escalera” (“Get Off My Ladder”) and “Molino mi Molinete” (“Mill, My Pinwheel”). As “Guardian of Tradition,” Nidia Góngora has collaborated with ensembles and musical projects such as Ale Kuma, Grupo Bahía, Herencia de Timbiquí, Dizzy Mandjeku, Pacífico Sinfónico, Ondatrópica, The Bongo Hop, Búhu, Montoya, Bomba Estéreo, Malecón, Orishas, La Pacifican Power, and British producer Quantic, among others.

Nidia Góngora’s versatility positions her as an intermediary between the traditional music communities of Colombia and the broader Afro-Latin region. She has also gained recognition on the international stages of Europe, Asia, and the United States.

For the past 12 years, Góngora has conducted ongoing musical training with children in both school and community settings, and in both rural and urban areas of Cauca and Valle del Cauca through the Fundación Escuela Canalón, a project that preserves and promotes the cultural identity values of the region.

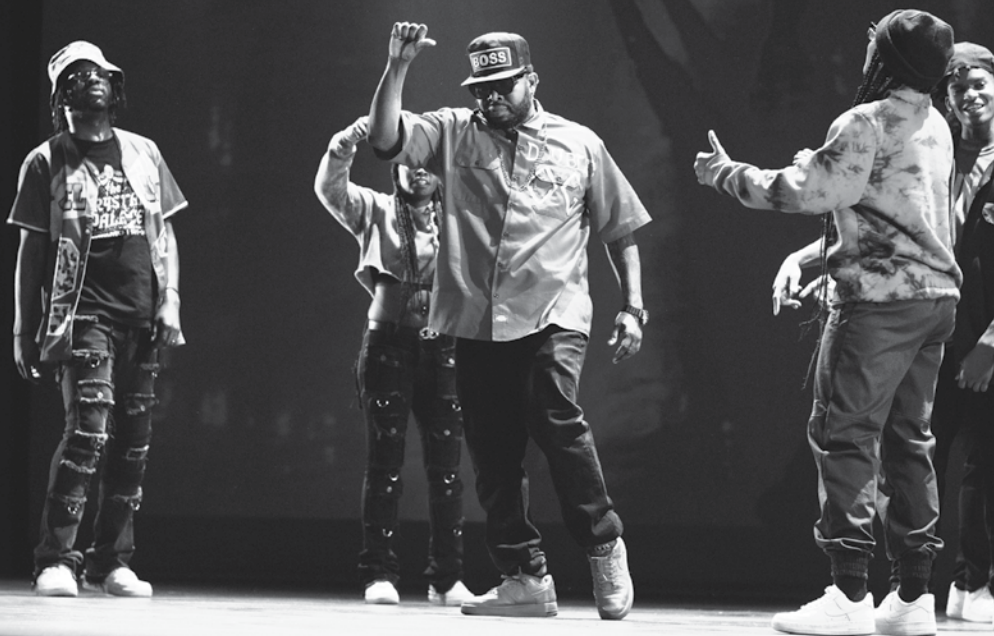
As a businesswoman and activist, Nidia Góngora is regarded as one of the most important female leaders and entrepreneurs in the country through creative projects such as Viche Positivo, her renowned brand of traditional Pacific beverages; her guest house, La Bella Sofía, in Timbiquí; and her festival, Arrullo en el Barrio. Maestra Nidia develops community social projects with families in the neighborhoods of Eastern Cali such as community kitchens and markets. The main beneficiaries are children, who receive prepared meals, engage in cultural activities such as singing and dancing, and receive gifts during Christmas festivities. For her work, Góngora has been featured in and on the covers of popular publications such as Dinero, Arcadia, El Espectador, The Guardian, and The New York Times.
